Origin

The grapes come from our own vineyards Schiefer, this is Hollenburg's oldest vineyard, dating to 1364.

Soil

20-160 cm loess over Konglomorat (primary rock formed during the Ice Age)

Tasting notes:

Only the healthiest and ripest grapes are refined in the finest barrique. Clear but beautifully integrated wood notes. Burgundy scent, green nuts, pinch of vanilla.

Soft, voluminous, creamy and powerful on the palate.

Absolutely unusual, even out of line dancing variety representative. A Mammut!

Vinification: 24 months in new French barrique

12 months sur lie

Tip: please open the bottle 2-3 hours before drinking

Alcohol: 14,0% vol Residual sugar: 1,6g/l Tartaric acid: 5,2 g/l
