



Weingut Forstreiter

Like hardly any other winery in the **Kremstal region** of Lower Austria, the **Forstreiter winery** succeeds in combining tradition and innovative spirit. With Tabor, for example, the winery owns the oldest vineyard in Austria with unimproved Grüner Veltliner vines and, with its wine cellar, which has grown organically for decades, one of the most modern wine production facilities in the region. Located in **Hollenburg**, the southeasternmost district of the white wine capital of Krems, the winery has been **family-owned since 1868** and, although it has grown from 28 to 54 hectares over the past decades, is still run as a family business in close connection with nature by the current winemaker Meinhard Forstreiter. The main variety is **Grüner Veltliner**, but **Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Gelber Muskateller** and red wines from **Zweigelt and St. Laurent** are also pressed and successfully exported to 17 different countries.



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
